Competition Rules	Upon the referee's signal, all competitors perform all valid kicks into electronic Deaedo PSS that are attached to the punching bag. Between two consecutive kicks, the executor leg must touch the ground. The points are being recorded by electronic shield and are visible on the result screen which is set in the competition area in front of the competitors. Kicks are performed with electronic Daedo sensor socks (All athletes must bring their own Daedo sensor socks), and competitors must be dressed in dobok with adequate belt. Drawing of couples will be carried out by the Organizing Committee. System of single elimination to finals. Duration: 1x20 sec. Competitors are divided into categories in accordance with their sex and year of birth.

Competition Rules	<p>Wood breaking boards will be provided by the organizer for free! Competitors must be dressed in dobok with adequate belt. Competitors are divided into categories in accordance with their sex and year of birth. After the signal of the referee, each competitor has sixty (60) seconds for each item in order to pre-judge the distance – compulsory, with no touch allowed, followed by the attempt to move the board. Competitors that exceed the prescribed time, or touch board during their pre-judging shall receive 0 points. Referees must examine each board before each attempt. Each of the competitors could participate in each style (Power/Special/Technical) ONLY once. The points will be add up/summed for each individual competitors, by making the rankings.</p>	
	Power breaking	A stand designed for kyokpa will be used. Each fully moved board will count as three (3) points . Each half moved board will count as one (1) point . The number of the the boards, chosen by the competitor. The competitor could choose technic from: apchumok, sonnal (1) extra point / board , sonkut (3) extra point / board .
	Special breaking	Two targets from one jump (4) points , three targets from one jump (6) points , four targets from one jump (8) points , five targets from one jump (12) points
	Technical Breaking	The competitor could choose between height breaking or lenght breaking . (10) points for the highest and longest breaking, (8) points for the second highest and longest breaking, (5) points for the third highest and longest breaking.
