Competition Rules

Entry fees

Competitors under the age of 18 can only take part in the event with a written consent form signed by a parent/legal guardian (see attached Declaration). Both the sports doctor's certificate and the parental declaration must be presented at the time of registration; these documents will not be accepted afterwards.

An additional requirement for hungarian competitors: They must present their valid membership card or book, and all fees related to their Hungarian Taekwondo Federation membership (including the annual membership fee) must be fully paid. Apart from that they must have a valid sport insurance.

Rules and regulations

Category A

- Competitors must know all possible poomsae in their category and age group.
- The poomsae to be performed will be randomly drawn from the official list.
- If a competitor is unable to perform the drawn poomsae, they may perform any other poomsae from their category, but will receive a score of 0.
- The draw will take place during the week of the competition, and the selected poomsae will be published on the organizer's website and social media: www.yellowsea.hu and the event's Facebook page.

Categories B & C

- No drawing will take place.
- Competitors are free to choose any poomsae from the official list for their category.
- In Categories B and C, competitors may choose to repeat the same poomsae in the next round if they choose to.
- In Category C, competitors who know only one poomsae, may repeat it even in the final round.
- In Category B, repeating the same poomsae in the final round will result in a score of 0 for the second poomsae.

Pair and Team Categories

- Pair: Only mixed-gender pairs (1 female + 1 male) are allowed.
- Team: Only same-gender teams (F/F/F or M/M/M) are permitted.
- The age group and belt category of a pair or team is determined by: The oldest member of the group, and the member with the highest belt rank.
- A competitor may participate in only one pair and only one team.

Age Group Classification

Age groups are determined based on the competitor's date of birth.



Competition



The competition will follow the cut-off system.

- Preliminary and semifinal rounds: Each competitor performs one poomsae.
- Final round: Competitors must perform two poomsae.

Each poomsae must be completed within 30 to 90 seconds. In the final round, there will be a 30–60 second waiting period between the two performances. Scoring resets in each round, scores do not carry over between rounds.

Progression to Finals

- Preliminary Round: If there are 20 or more competitors, the top 50% (rounded up in case of an odd number) will advance to the semifinals.
- Semifinal Round: If there are 9–19 competitors, the competition will start with the semifinal. The top 8 scorers will qualify for the final.
- Final Only: If there are 8 or fewer competitors, only the final round will be held.

Additional Provisions

- The Head Referee, in agreement with the organizers, reserves the right to change the competition format for Categories B and C at the start of the event. Coaches will be notified in advance of any changes.
- The award ceremony for each age group will take place immediately after the corresponding final.

Prize:

- Medal and certificate for I-III. places.
- Team ranking: A trophy will be awarded for I.-V. places in the top 5 overall team of the competition. (scoring method is: 7 points for 1st place, 3 points for 2nd place and 1 point for 3rd place)

ATTENTION!

- In any age group or category where only one competitor is registered, the competitor must still perform the required poomsae for that category.
- The result will count towards the team ranking.

Protest

Only an official coach is allowed to protest. An amount of HUF 20 000 ($50 \in$) will have to be paid for each protest A protest is only allowed if it is suspected that a clerical or scoring error was made by a referee or official (e.g., input error in the results). The decision of the head referee is final.

Other information

The team/club leader may register on behalf of their students at the registration with the presentation of the membership cards, sports doctor permission, insurance, payment of entry fees and parent permission. We expressively ask everbody to arrive on time so the registration can be completed by 8:45 a.m.

To submit entries via the website, you must first register, then request approval for the competition. Only after approval will the registration surface become active.
